


#### **Reduce Size & Scope of the Federal Government**

- Explicit plan for reshaping public discourse on civil rights issues.



#### **Goal: Dismantle the Administrative State**

- Mandate for Leadership 2025
- Nearly 1,000-page
- Reshape and do away with the "deep state"
- Fire as many as 50,000 federal workers.
- Replace with "loyalists"
- Dramatically increase executive power





#### **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**

- Abolish the Department of Education, devolve all functions to states.
- Expand school voucher programs and religious school funding.
- Eliminate student loan forgiveness programs.
- Risks gutting protections for disadvantaged students, reducing educational opportunities, and increasing inequality.

#### **DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE**

- Review and terminate FBI investigations deemed contrary to partisan interests.
- Prosecute leaks aggressively.
- Eliminate or constrain internal oversight bodies.
- Politicizes impartial law enforcement, obstructs legitimate oversight, and increases potential for abuse of power.





## DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

- Appoint pro-life leadership to restrict access to abortion and contraception.
- Reverse protections for transgender patients.

- Infringes on reproductive rights, guts safety net programs for the most vulnerable populations, and strips healthcare protections.

## ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

- Empower states to set environmental standards over federal EPA.
- Focus only on core statutory missions, not climate or environmental justice.
- Open scientific advisory boards to industry representatives.
- Threatens national standards for clean air, water, opens doors for undisclosed corporate influence over public safeguards.





## DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY

- Restructure or break up DHS agencies like FEMA, TSA, Border Patrol.
- Prioritize immigration enforcement over humanitarian concerns.
- Eliminate cybersecurity and intelligence functions.
- Raises issues of loss of coordination, unchecked immigration actions, and US vulnerability to cyber threats.

- □ I believe that everyone should have safe access to vote and that everyone's vote must be counted, without interference or intimidation. This is an essential human right and a core commitment of any healthy democracy.
  - □ I pledge to vote if I am eligible to do so and to stand against voter suppression all its forms.

  - I pledge to work nonviolently to protect those in my community under threat from election related or racist motivated violence.





### #1 - The Threat to Our Democracy

- Power at all costs The GOP appears willing to sacrifice our democracy in order to stay in power.
- **Unpopular Policies** GOP policies are widely unpopular with the majority of Americans (guns, abortion, healthcare, etc.)
- Functional Autocracies Red states are effectively becoming autocracies with little accountability to the local people.
- A Bleak Future Once lost, democracy and its associated freedoms, are very difficult to regain.
- A Personalist Dictatorship Trump's stated goal of consolidating executive power if elected is a blueprint for a "Putinstyle" personalist dictatorship.

# 4d. Write or Call Your Representatives

#### WHEN TO WRITE OR CALL YOUR REPRESENTATIVE

If you have time, make a call or write a letter to your representative. A call or letter will probably get the most attention, but a personal email can also be effective.

#### Write to:

- call attention to an issue or need
- thank them for addressing an issue or need
- share your disappointment or frustration with their actions

#### MESSAGING STRATEGIES



- 11. If your state offers vote-by-mail, go to retirement communities.







# Top 5 Reasons to Commit to Monthly Recurring Donations

#### 1. To increase revenue

 Recurring donors give an average of 42% more per year than donors who give one-time donations.

#### 2. To increase donor retention

- "Over 70% of people of one-time donors don't come back.
- First-year retention rate for monthly donors is 80%.

#### 3. To decrease operating costs

 It takes more resources and expenses to recruit new donors than to engage with existing donors.





## OPPORTUNITIES FOR BUSINESSES TO SUPPORT DEMOCRACY

- **1. Notify your audience and customers** about voter registration.
- 2. Notify employees about voter registration.
- **3. Host voter registration** and absentee ballot application drives at high-traffic locations.
- 4. Engage celebrities to encourage the public to register to vote and remind people of important election deadlines.
- Help educate your audience, customers, and employees about voting by mail and early voting.
- **6. Provide absentee ballot applications** to employees or customers, where possible.
- **7. Provide paid time off** for employees to vote—by mail or in person.
- 8. Provide mail-processing equipment.
- 9. Offer spaces for ballot drop boxes

- 10. Offer large spaces to be used as polling locations
- 11. Provide safe and free transportation to the polls
- 12. Provide polling places with much-needed supplies
- 13. Provide support and protective gear to voters waiting in line
- 14. Recognize—and incentivize—the service of poll workers
- 15. Offer free childcare for corporate employees or other individuals serving as poll workers
- 16. Ask corporate executives to lead by example by volunteering as poll workers themselves
